

Group Policy FAQ's at Assisted Living Site

ORU Music Therapy Clinic provides group music therapy services for assisted living facilities in the Tulsa area. Off-site contract groups are comprised of resident's from a specific long term care facility. A minimum of 6 individual clients with a maximum of 8 clients is recommended per group session with at least one facility staff/assistant required. More staff may be necessary depending on the functioning level of the clients. Additional clients may be added with approval from the music therapist. Multiple groups may be scheduled. The contract is based on Oral Roberts University semester calendar.

How does it work?

The ORU Music Therapy Clinic offers weekly on-site music therapy services led by a board-certified music therapist to the residents at the assisted living facility. Client policy and procedure packets will be provided.

How much do music therapy sessions cost?

A weekly group music therapy session (45 minutes) at your facility costs \$15 per individual resident.

How does payment work?

Facility is responsible for collecting/managing payment, and the facility pays music therapy service fee to ORU Music Therapy Clinic directly. Payments may be made in advance by month or semester (approximately four to four and half months).

What if a client can't attend? Is a refund given?

No. If a resident is unable to attend due to illness or other circumstances, ORU Music Therapy Clinic does not provide a refund for individuals under group contract. If the absence of an individual resident continues for the rest of the semester, the contracted facility can replace the resident or rearrange the group after consultation with the music therapist.

Can different residents attend each week?

No. Therapeutic goals and objectives are designed to meet the needs of the clients in the group. Therefore, it is recommended that the same clients attend each week.
