††† Students enroll in **GHPE 703**, Graduate Health Fitness, an on-line course. **GHPE 715**, Graduate Aerobics and **GHPE 725**, Graduate Walk, are also on-line courses. Students who are alumni and have already completed Graduate Health Fitness, either in the undergraduate or graduate programs, may take only Graduate Aerobics or Graduate Walk, and may take the same elective twice. Active Duty Military Chaplains can submit their DDE or JST forms to receive credit for GHPE 715 or 725, and will enroll in GHPE 703.

+ After successful completion of all coursework and candidacy level assessment, students proceed to the Ministry Research Project and implementation phase which may take 1-3 years. DMIN 792, Ministry Project, is offered each Fall and Spring semester. More information is in the DMIN Handbook and Manual.
