
ORU INTERNATIONAL STUDENT NEWSLETTER #2

VISA INTERVIEW TIPS

- Dress well
- Always say the truth
- Establish a strong tie to your home country
- Be confident while answering questions
- Make sure your answers are in alignment with the information on the DS-160 you have submitted
- Do not submit any false documents



DOCUMENTS TO BRING

- Form I-20 issued by ORU
- Printed Form DS-160 "Online Nonimmigrant Visa Application," confirmation page
- Passport is valid for at least six months after you plan to enter the United States
- A two-inch by two-inch photo of yourself
- Receipt for your \$160 visa application fee payment
- Receipt for your I-901 SEVIS fee payment.
- Admission letter from ORU
- Financial Guarantee Form and Bank Statement preferably 2 months old or less for bank statement
- Certificates, transcript, and any test results
- Information proving the student intends to return to their home country after studies. This can be an introductory letter from the workplace.
