

Dr. Stephen Wheat, Professor of Computer Science, received a \$399,382 Advanced Cyber-Infrastructure Grant from the National Science Foundation this spring. In short, it will enable a GPU-based server partition called Eli to integrate with Titan, ORU's supercomputer.


Dr. Thelzy Zamarrón '18



TREVINO AND ROMANO: ALL-STARS!








Jordan Romano
