10 Commandments of Truly Human Leadership

1. Intentionally begin your day focused on the lives you will touch.
2. Remember: Leadership is about STEWARDING the lives entrusted to you.
3. Send everyone home each day Safe, Healthy & Fulfilled.
4. Align EVERYTHING to an inspirational vision of a better future.
5. TRUST is the foundation of everything. Act like it.

10 Commandments of Truly Human Leadership

6. Intentionally look for goodness in people.

Then, recognize & celebrate it.

7. Ask no more—no less than you would of your own child.

8. Lead with grounded OPTIMISM.

9. Discover and adapt to each person's UNIQUENESS.

10. Measure SUCCESS by how you touch others' lives.

So, how can YOU possibly become a Great Leader?

You CAN'T! (by yourself)

**“All of God is in

Everything of God gets expressed in Christ, so you can see and hear him clearly. You don't need a telescope, a microscope, or a horoscope to realize the fullness of Christ, and the emptiness of the universe without him. When you come to him, **that fullness comes together in you, too**. His power extends over everything.

Col 2:8-10

He LIVES in us!

But if God himself has taken up **residence in your life**, you can hardly be thinking more of yourself than of him. Anyone, of course, who has not welcomed this invisible but clearly present God, the Spirit of Christ, won't know what we're talking about.

But for you who welcome him, **in whom he dwells**—even though you still experience all the limitations of sin—you yourself experience life on God's terms... When God lives and breathes in you (and he does, as surely as he did in Jesus), you are delivered from that dead life. With **his Spirit living in you**, your body will be as alive as Christ's!

This mystery has been kept in the dark for a long time, but now it's out in the open. God wanted everyone, not just Jews, to know this rich and glorious secret inside and out, regardless of their background, regardless of their religious standing. The mystery in a nutshell is just this: **Christ is in you**, so therefore you can look forward to sharing in God's glory. It's that simple.
