<sup>2</sup>Performance Group must include 4 credits of MUS 061-065, 067-075, 080, 085, 086 and 4 credits of MUS 089. Guitar majors may use guitar ensemble for four semesters to count toward major ensemble credit. Jazz Combo, Jazz Ensemble, Ladies & Gentlemen of Jazz and Opera

Theatre students can receive up to two credits for participation in these groups out of the eight semesters of performance groups credits required.

<sup>3</sup>Oratorio Chorus must be taken in addition to any other choral group taken Fall Semesters.
