CHECKLIST

Application, fee, essay, and signed Honor Code.

Be sure to include the \$35 processing fee, personal essay (typed not hand written) and a signed copy of the Honor Code as your application cannot be processed until all of these have been received.

□ Request your high school or GED transcript.

Call your high school or state board of education and request that an official transcript (with a raised seal) be sent directly to ORU Online Campus. This can be faxed by your high school or board of education, but the original transcript will still need to be mailed to complete your file.

Request official college transcripts.

An official transcript can be faxed by your college but the original transcript will still need to be mailed to complete your file.

Give the Minister's Recommendation form to your minister.

This form is to be completed and returned by your minister or other church leader who is not a relative. After filling out the top portion of the form, please ask your minister to mail or fax the recommendation directly to ORU Online Campus.

Go online to www.fafsa.ed.gov and complete the "Free Application for Federal Student Aid." Financial aid is only awarded or considered for U.S. citizens and permanent residents. Student must take at least six credit hours per semester to qualify for federal aid.

All students must be prepared to pay for textbooks at the time of enrollment.

When all documents have been received, the Admissions Committee will evaluate the applicant's file. A letter of notification will be mailed after the Admissions Committee's decision has been made. An evaluation of prior academic work will take place at this time, and a degree plan sheet will be mailed. Applicants admitted to the program will be assigned an enroll-ment counselor to assist in the enrollment process.
