This minor is for students majoring in business administration, biblical literature, Christian caregiving and counseling, government, or communication. The minor is offered via distance learning through the History, Humanities, and Government department in the ORU College of Arts and Cultural Studies.

The liberal studies minor requires a total of 18 hours of coursework and must meet the following stipulations: (1) the minor must include at least 6 hours of upper division courses (courses numbered 300 or higher), (2) the 18 hours must be related coursework (i.e., in the same subject area), and (3) the minor must be approved by Distance Learning and the Registrar's office.
