Who is eligible?

• Students in their final two semesters of undergraduate studies with a 3.0 cumulative GPA

How many Graduate Courses can be taken in a semester?

• Students may register for up to six credit hours of graduate level courses in their final two undergraduate semesters or three credit hours in a summer session.

What is the benefit of Fast Track?

- Students can earn up to 12 credit hours of graduate work while completing their undergraduate degree.
- Students <u>SAVE MONEY!</u>

No extra tuition charge when taking between 12.5 and 18.5 credit hours at the undergraduate level. Students pay undergraduate tuition rate per credit hour in summer sessions or when enrollment is either below 12.5 or exceeds 18.5 semester hours. As much as one semester of graduate work can be completed saving student's tuition, fees, and living expenses.

<u>Add it all up</u> and the savings could be worth <u>\$7040</u> (savings based on a single graduate student financial aid budget of tuition, fees, room and board)

How to sign up!

- 1. Complete and submit the Fast Track application to your ORU graduate school representative.
- 2. Upon approval, see your graduate school advisor for choosing appropriate courses.
- 3. Enroll with an Adult Learning Service Center Enrollment Staff.
