## **\$2.2 MILLION GRANT**

The U.S. Department of Education made ORU's day recently. From its Strengthening Institutions Program, the department awarded ORU a \$2.2 million grant that will help the university improve the six-year graduation rate and expand academic support for at-risk students, among other goals. This is the largest academic grant in ORU's history.
