HONORING EDUCATORS

ORU's College of Education received a 2022 Frank Murray Leadership Award for Continuous Improvement. As the name of the award indicates, it is given to providers like the COE that are committed to continuous improvement as they prepare future teachers of students from pre-school through 12th grade. Honorees are also accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation and achieved this accreditation with no stipulations or areas for improvement. Only 32 of the CAEP's 471 educator preparation providers were singled out for recognition this year.



MEN'S SOCCER ACCOLADES

Forward Felipe D'Agostini, the 2021 Newcomer of the Year in men's soccer, was named the Offensive Player of the Year in the Summit League. Redshirt senior Jeremy Coste was named the Goalkeeper of the Year. In all, five Golden Eagles earned All-League First Team honors. Head coach Ryan Bush earned Coach of the Year honors for the third time in the last four seasons. The team also won the regular-season championship outright for the first time since 2004.



HEAD OF THE CLASS

Caleb Green will be the only former ORU athlete honored during Hall of Fame night on Saturday, January 28. As one of the best men's basketball players to ever wear the Golden Eagle uniform, Caleb stands at #3 on ORU's all-time scoring list with 2,503 points. That's just one measure of the impact he had on a team that went to the NIT (2005) and to the NCAA Tournament two years in a row (2006, 2007). Caleb was also a three-time All-American and conference Player of the Year.
