CONTRACT EXTENDED

On July 31, ORU Board of Trustees Chair Holly Moore '86 announced that the board had voted to extend President Wilson's contract through 2033. He recently celebrated his tenth anniversary as ORU's fourth president. During his tenure, ORU has seen a steady rise in enrollment, the opening of four new buildings (with another—the Media Arts Center—on the way), transformative renovations in existing buildings, a new sports complex for student-athletes and a sports park for intramurals, more scholarship funding, and more alumni and friends stepping up to offer financial support. Still on the way: the David and Barbara Green Centre for Global Leadership, two new residence halls, a new dining hall, and a "rooms-to-suites" renovation of Claudius Roberts and E. M. Roberts residence halls. (Note: All new buildings have been constructed debt-free, without using any tuition dollars.)

NEW THEOLOGY DEAN

The College of Theology and Ministry has a new dean: Dr. Adrian Hinkle. She comes to ORU from Southwestern Christian University, where she served as vice president of academic affairs for six years. Other positions she held at SCU included chair of theology and missions and academic dean for the school of graduate and professional studies. In addition, Dr. Hinkle is the executive director of the Society for Pentecostal Studies.


