SPEAKING OF THE GREEN CENTRE...



ORU Baseball's Easton Teel is a Freshman All-American! He earned Perfect Game Second Team Freshman All-American honors. He had a 7-2 record in 2025, and led the Summit League with a 2.95 ERA. He was also the league's Newcomer of the Year.
