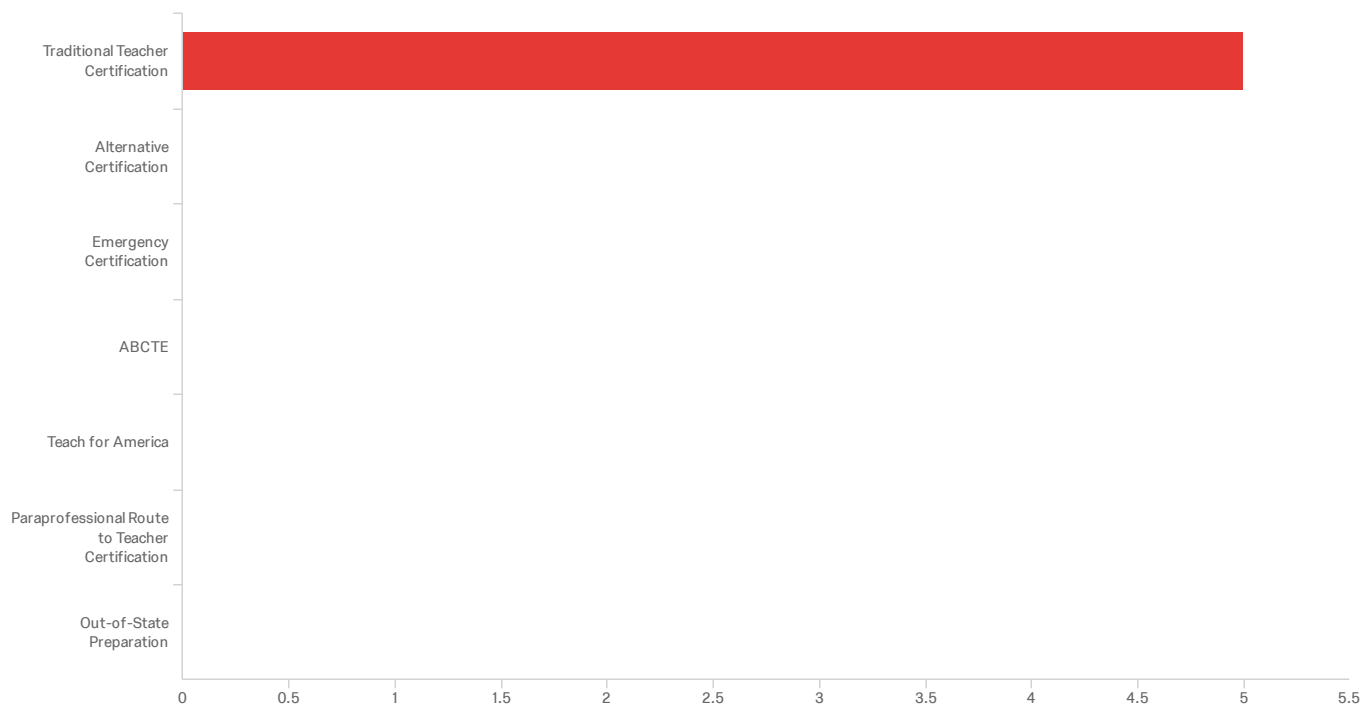

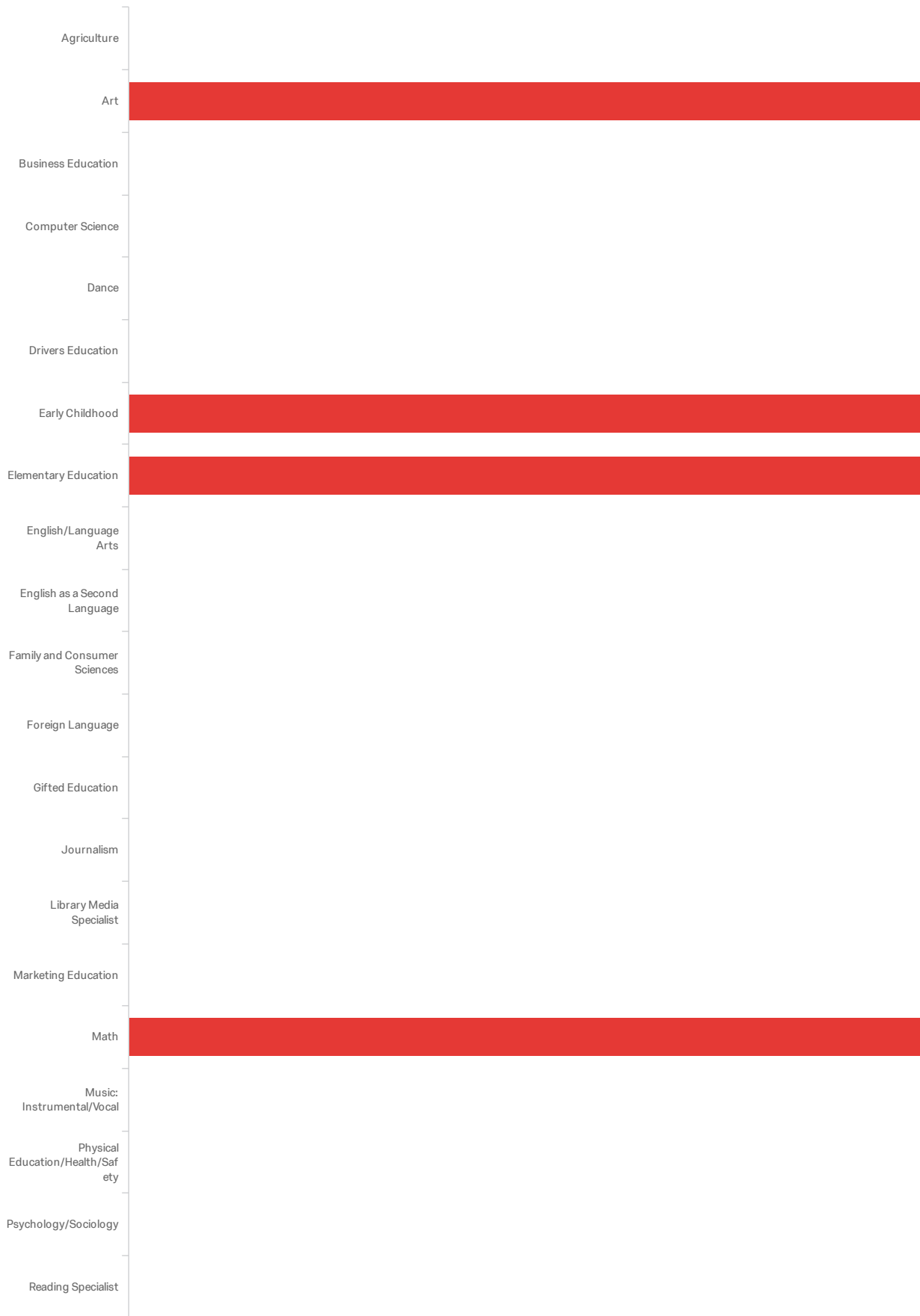

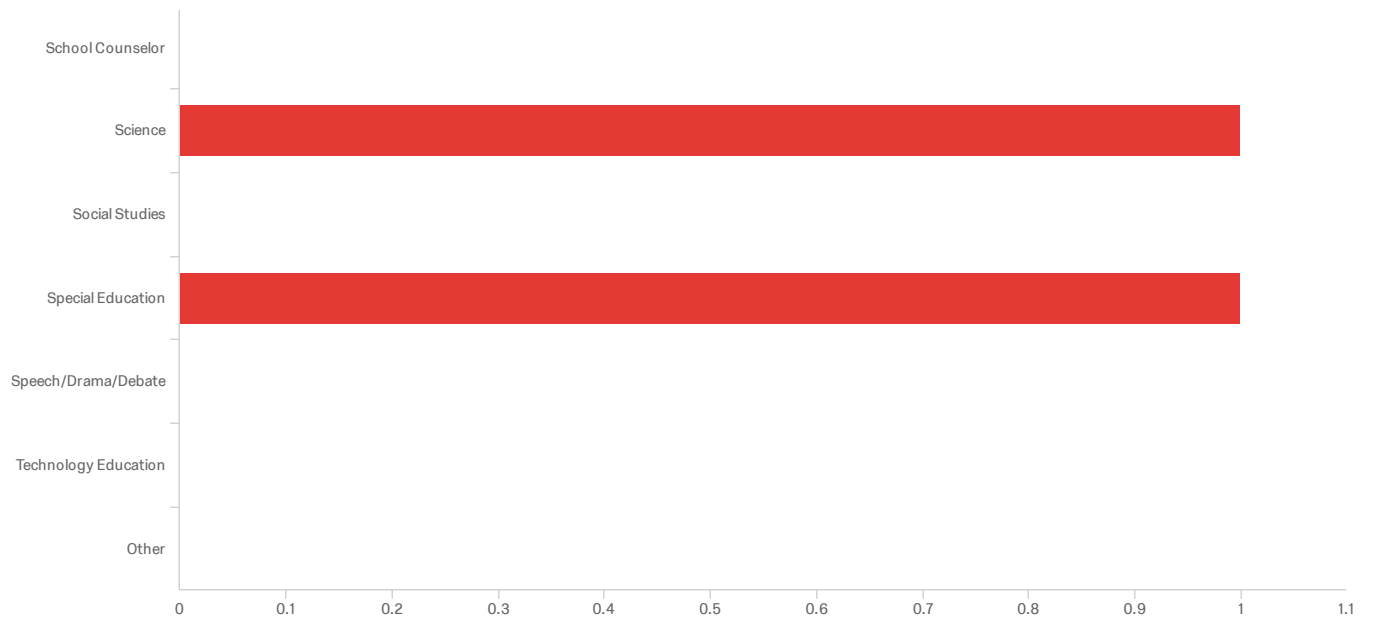

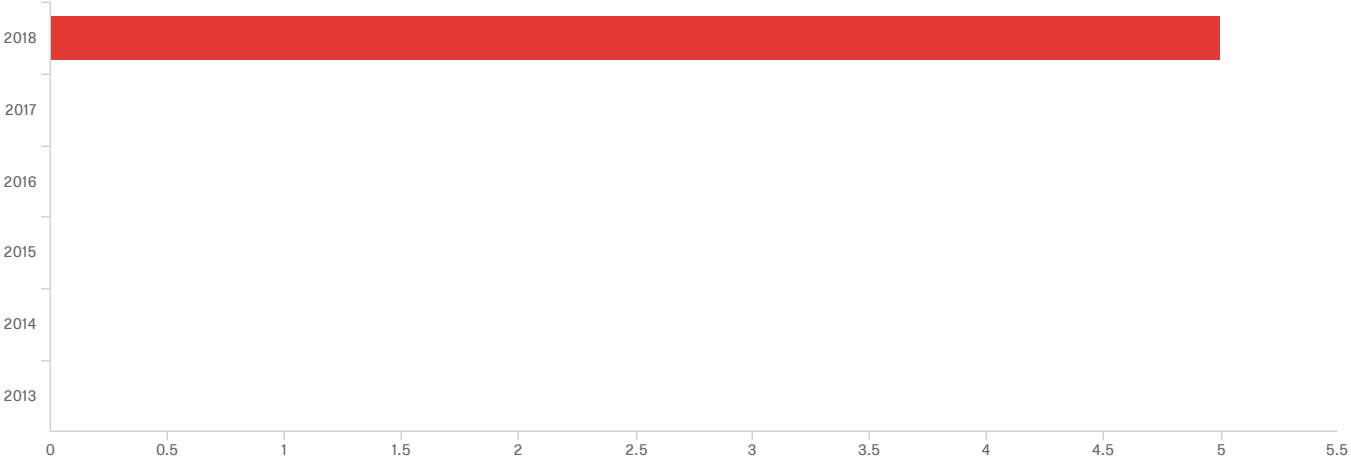

2a. In what area did you receive your degree?



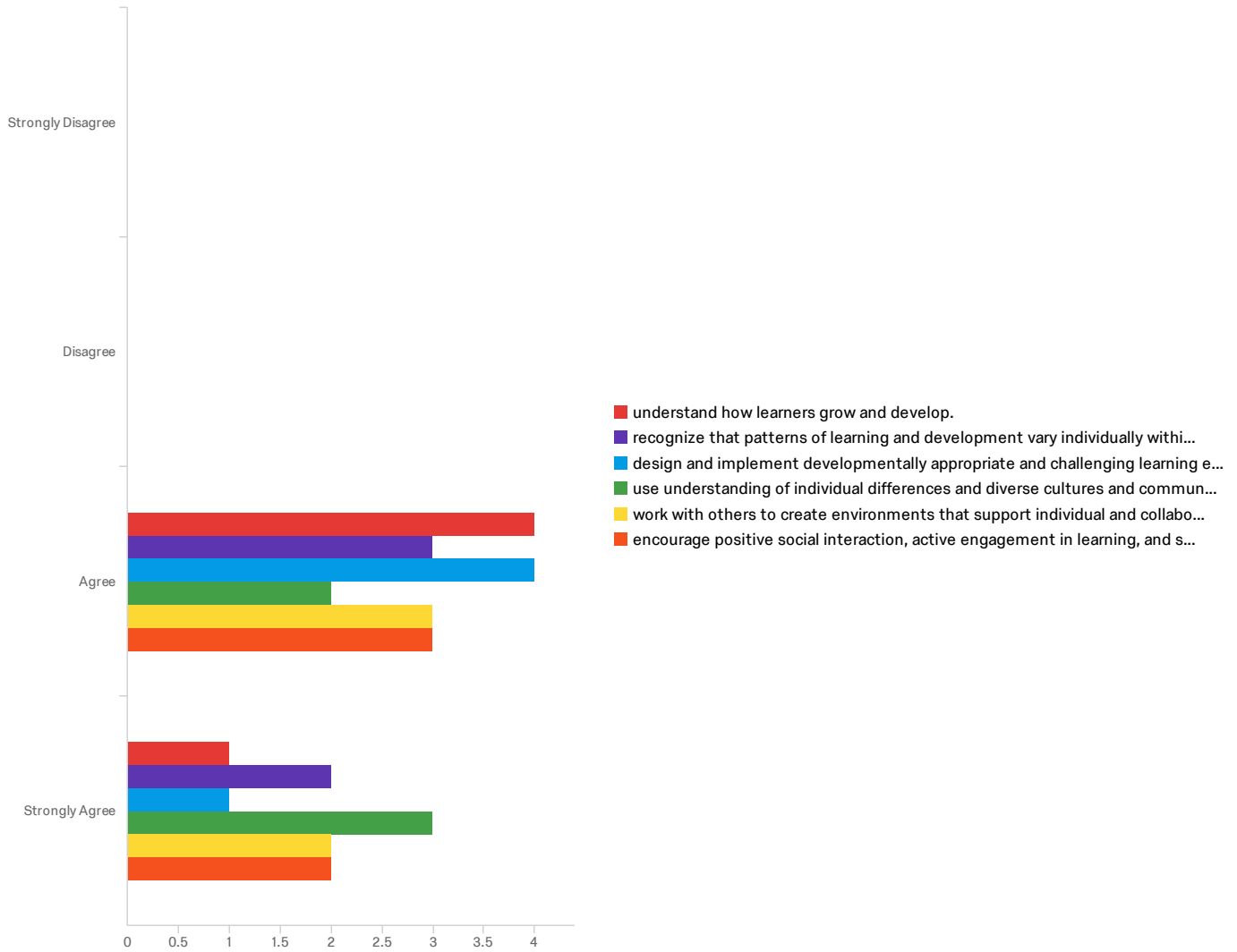


2b. In what year did you receive your degree?

All of my Elementary and Secondary Methods and Evaluation classes with Professor Chenoweth were really helpful and eye-opening.

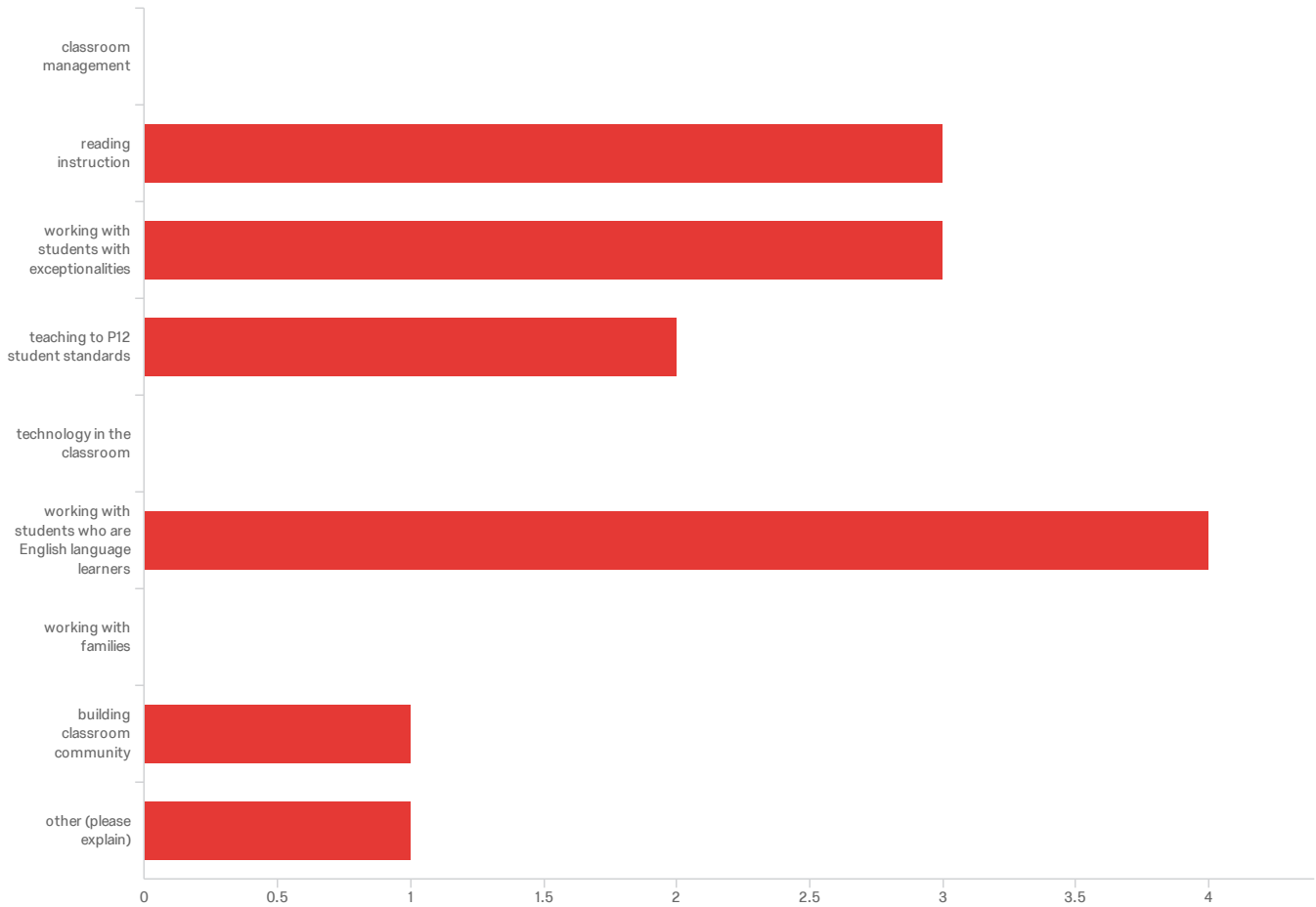
There was a course relating to directly teaching mathematics and developing the curriculum itself that was the most impactful.

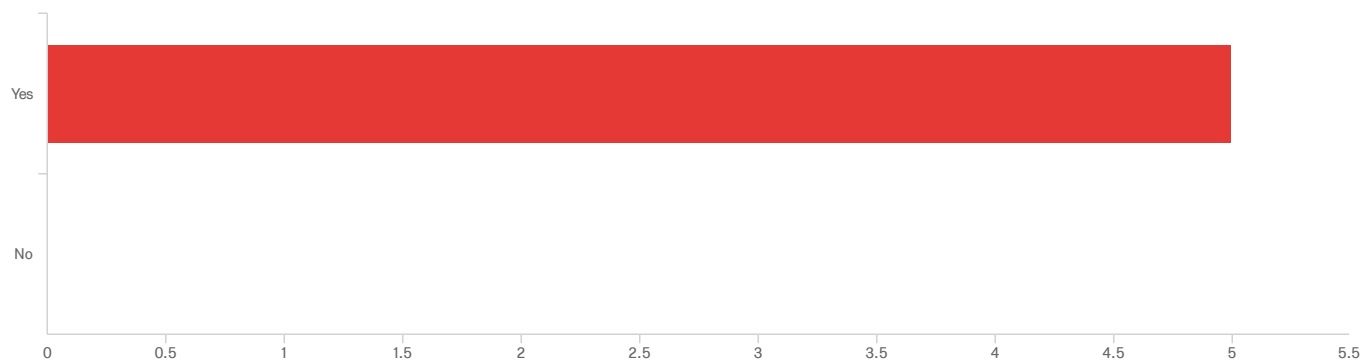

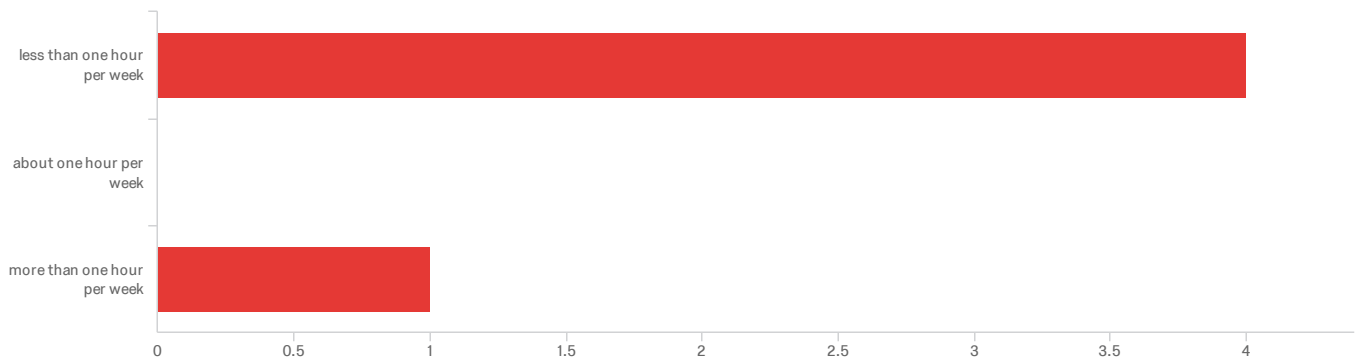

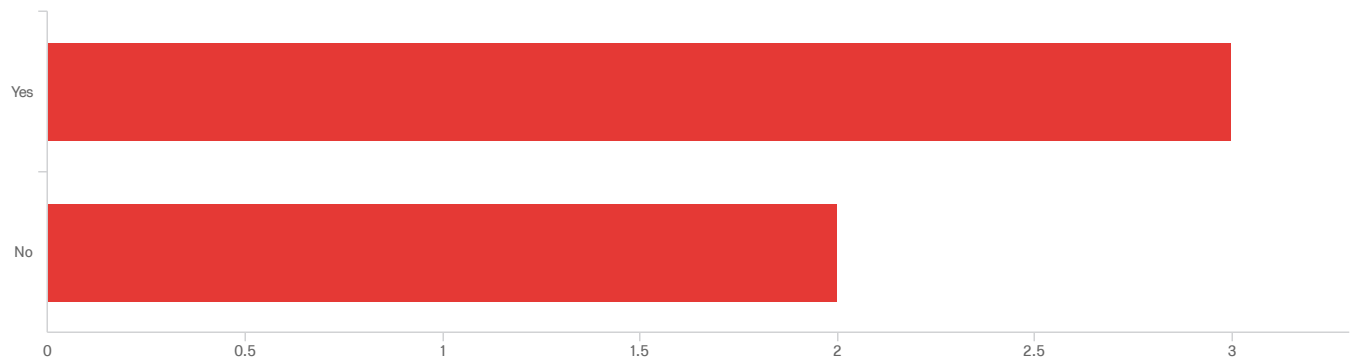
11a. How much time did you spend with your mentor teacher?

11b. Is your mentor in your same teaching area?

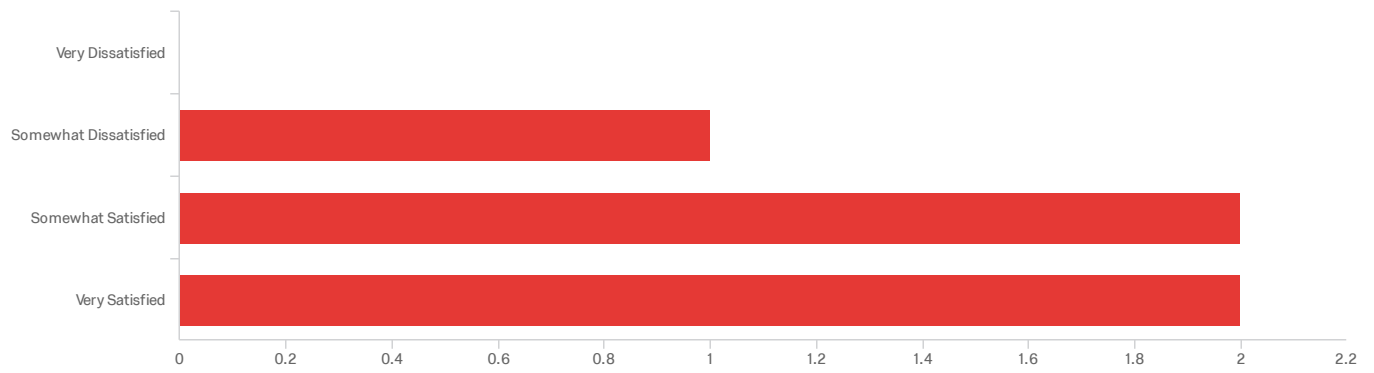

I was also unaware of the teaching expectations. I learned one style and developed my own during my degree but that way is not ideal at this school. It would have been nice to have received this information upon my arrival and been observed more without necessarily getting a score but more feedback. I heard all year that I was doing a great job and then the last 8 weeks I am told I need to completely change my teaching style to meet the school's standards. However, I do not feel that these standards apply to teaching art. The room functions very differently than other classrooms and I do not feel that it should be held to the same expectations.

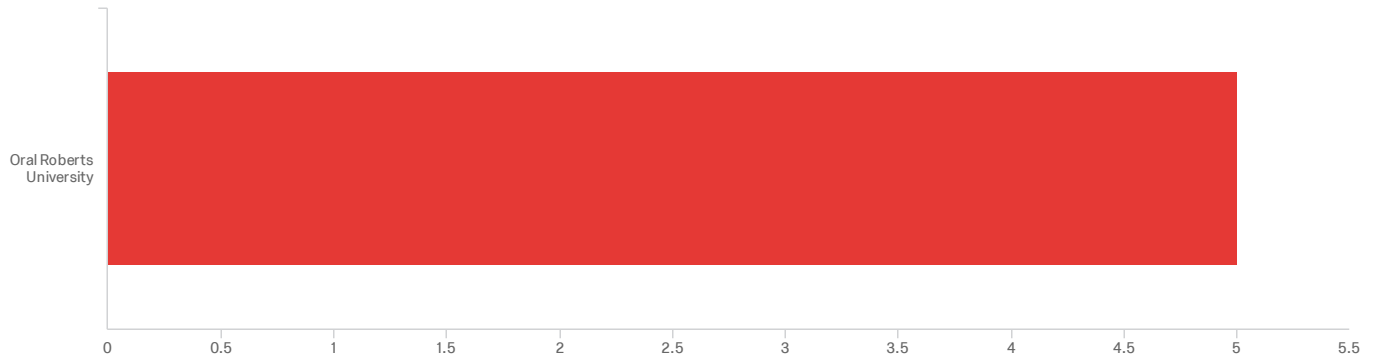
Honestly, having the same plan period or days to purposefully plan with my mentor teacher would be the most helpful.

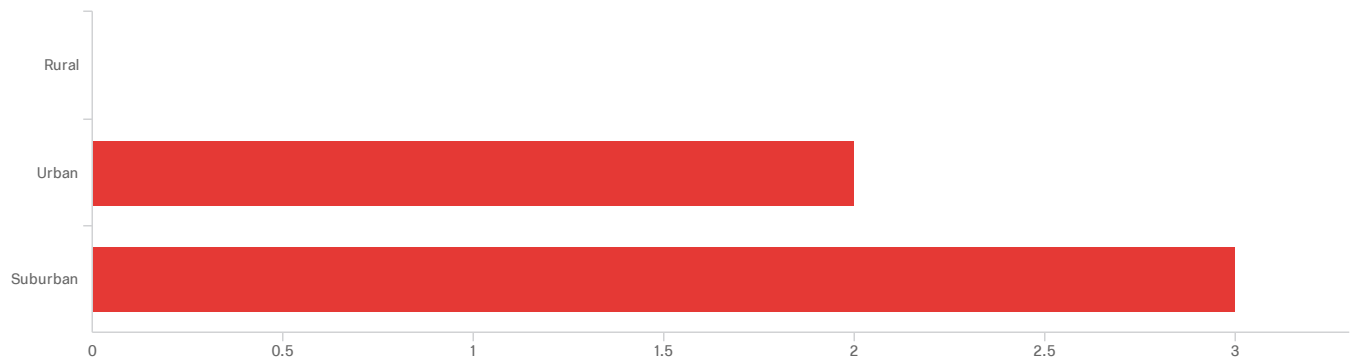

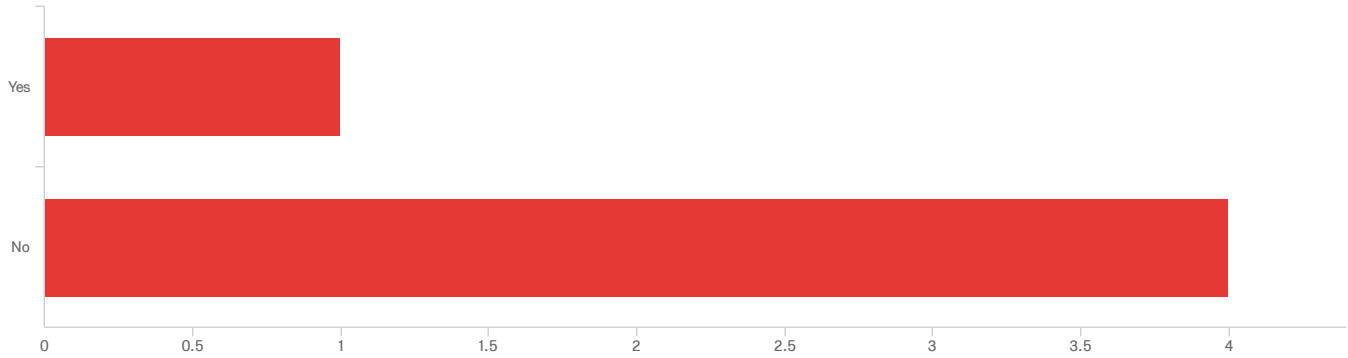
18. Which of the following describes your school district?
