ADVANCED DISPOSITION DATA AUGUST 1, 2007 – DECEMBER 17, 2013

In addition to advanced candidate dispositions being assessed prior to entry into the program based on the recommendation letters, candidate dispositions are assessed during the internship. Specifically, ELCC Standard 5: Professional, Ethical Leaders addresses dispositions such as acts with integrity, acts fairly, and acts ethically. If a candidate is noted as having dispositional concerns, it is presented before the Graduate Council and appropriate action is taken.

Data indicates that candidates possess the dispositions required to have a positive impact in an educational environment. Assessment scores range from a high of 3.91 (District level Subareas 5.2 and 5.3) to a low of 3.83 (Building level subarea 5.2).
