

AGGREGATE SCORES FOR THE OGET AUGUST 1, 2011 – OCTOBER 17, 2013

Candidates are required to pass the Oklahoma General Education Test prior to admittance to the Teacher Education Program; therefore all scores are at the Acceptable level or above. Data represents aggregate scores for all programs from 2011 to 2013. Candidate scores range from a low of 2.28 (2011-12) in the area of Critical Thinking Skills: Writing to a high of 3.56 in the area of Critical Thinking: Mathematics (2011-2012). The writing score is consistently lower than the other scores. The unit implemented Test Prep Nights at which a faculty member works with candidates to improve writing strategies. Evidence suggests that there is an improvement in candidates test scores in that subarea as a result of these study sessions.
