AGGREGATE SCORES FOR THE OKLAHOMA PROFESSIONAL TEACHER EXAM (OPTE) AUGUST 1, 2011 – OCTOBER 17, 2013

Candidates typically take the Oklahoma Professional Teachers Exam during the spring semester. This report was run in the fall of 2013; therefore data were not available for fall 2013 at the time of the report. Candidate scores range from a low of 1.73 (2011-2012) in the area of Constructed Response: Critical Analysis Module to a high of 3.07 (2012-2013) in the area of Learner and the Learning Environment. Scores are consistently lower in the constructed response areas than other subareas of the test. The unit will need to look at embedding more writing strategies that are aligned with the Constructed Response subareas into its pedagogy courses.
