

# AGGREGATE SCORES FOR TRANSCRIPT GRADE POINT AVERAGE AUGUST 1, 2011 – OCTOBER 17, 2013

Looking at each course, scores range from a low of 3.17 (fall 2013) in the Foundations & Methods course to 4.00 (fall 2013) in both Oral Communications and Language Proficiency. Therefore, GPA scores provide evidence that candidates are at the Competent level or above in required courses prior to admittance into the Teacher Education Program.
