

FIELD EXPERIENCE SELF-EVALUATION DATA AUGUST 1, 2011 – OCTOBER 17, 2013

Currently an overall aggregate score is collected for the Field Experience Self-Evaluation instrument. Candidates rate themselves in the areas of personal fitness for teaching: appearance, emotional control, enthusiasm, health, sense of humor, tact, and voice; they also rate themselves in professional attitudes and competence: attendance, cooperation, dependability, English usage, initiative, promptness and resourceful at the completion of the first field experience. The data shows that candidates rated themselves at the competent level for 2 consecutive years 2011-2012 to 2012-2013). However, in fall 2013, students rated themselves at the acceptable level. This data is however limited as in 2013, the assessment system transitioned to a new design.
