AGGREGATE SCORES FOR STUDENT TEACHING INTERNSHIP TECHNOLOGY DATA AUGUST 1, 2011 – DECEMBER 30, 2013

The aggregate score covers the period from 2011-2013. Prior to fall 2012 one aggregate score for the entire Student Teacher Performance Evaluation was available; therefore no individual technology scores were available for 2011. From fall 2012, data collected for the unit using the Student Teacher Performance Evaluation Rubric was disaggregated into up to 30 criterions; one of which is the area of Technology or Instruction Media.

The data indicates that candidates demonstrate proficiency in utilizing technology during their student teaching internships to support the learning objectives. Individual candidates were consistently rated between the Competent and Exemplary level by both University Supervisors and Cooperating Teachers in the area of instruction-media.
