

Let's Get Started! Designing your program.

Advance planning is one of the keys to a successful internship program. The following six guidelines should help you get started in establishing an internship site:

- **Job Description**: Your internship program should include specific duties and projects. It is also important to include the timing (fall, spring, or summer), hours (part- or full-time), and compensation in the description.
- **Supervision:** Interns should be paired with an on-site supervisor. The supervisor should be readily available to the intern during the experience and should meet on a regular basis.
- **Objectives and Assignments:** It is helpful to delegate projects that have a definite beginning and end within the internship time frame. This allows interns to have concrete and measurable outcomes at the conclusion of the experience.
- Promotion: Posting an internship on a hiring system such as the Golden Hire Network is a great way to market your internship. Here students send resumes and stay in direct contact with you. You may also want to participate in oncampus activities such as; career fairs, information sessions, and on-campus interviews to reach the right candidates. - **Selection Process**: Recruiting interns is similar to selecting an entry-level professional employee. The interview process can be conducted at your organization or on the ORU campus depending upon the strategies you are utilizing to reach the right students.
- **Finalization**: Internships have become extremely competitive in today's job market; therefore, a prompt response in the selection process is very important. Depending on the academic field, many employers recruit and make offers at least one semester prior to its beginning.
