INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ADMISSION POLICY

International high school students can attend the ORU Early College for High School students program for either two or four weeks to take for-credit courses. Students will be issued an I-20 which is to be taken to the U.S. embassy in their country of origin to obtain the F-1 student visa.

Acceptance is subject to meeting ORU admission requirements. The admittance process will be based on the student's GPA and one of the following: ACT, SAT or TOEFL scores. Students who do not meet minimum admission requirements will be required to enroll in academic success and readiness courses.

Students will also be required to complete a financial guarantee prior to the issuance of an I-20.

International students who will subsequently attend ORU in the fall of the year of attendance at ORU Early College will need to make alternative arrangements for their accommodation at the end of the summer program and prior to resuming at ORU.
