**Writing Across the Curriculum Excellence Award**

**Statement of Purpose:** The award is to recognize excellence in the use of writing in the classroom to facilitate student learning.

**Guidelines:**

- Any full-time or part-time faculty member from any discipline who has not won the award in the last three years is eligible to apply.
- Applicants may submit descriptions of any kind of student writing assignments that encourage learning. Types of writing assignments can include, for example, informal assignments, formal assignments, writing-to-learn assignments, writing projects in the discipline, or projects combining technology and student writing.
- Interested faculty members should submit a completed application form and its accompanying materials to **Lori Kanitz, Director of Writing Across the Curriculum, English and Modern Languages Department, GC 5A02.**
- The deadline for applications is **Monday, April 1, 2013.**
- Winners will be selected by the Writing Across the Curriculum Committee on the basis of the effective design and implementation of student writing assignments that develop students' abilities to think critically and write well. Winners will be notified by the end of May 2013.
- The winner will be awarded a plaque and \$300.00
