Current Wording

"Each elected senator shall be elected to a one or two-year term as determined by their academic department with a maximum term limit of four years before relinquishing the seat for a minimum of two years. If the University Faculty elects a senator as Faculty Senate Vice-President, the term limitations do not apply during the two-year term of commitment."

Proposed Wording

"Each elected senator shall be elected to a one or two-year term as determined by their academic department with a maximum term limit of four years before relinquishing the seat for a minimum of two years. If the University Faculty elects a senator as Faculty Senate Vice President for their fourth year, the term limitations do not apply during the fifth year and they may serve a fifth year as a senator and as Senate President. Then the senator must sit out for two years after his/her service as President before being re-elected as a senator, VP, or President."

Rationale

The original intent was to count Senators' years served as VP and President toward the total 4 years served while not allowing a VP to term limit out and not become President. That is, senators serve a maximum of four years with a potential fifth year if that fifth year is served as president.
