- 6) New programs not needing Senate approval were presented. The College of Arts and Cultural Studies reported on: Chinese Mandarin, Global Studies (Asian, Latin America, and Middle East), and Contemporary Option for the Music Performance major. The College of Science and Engineering reported on Industrial/Organizational Psychology and Social Justice. The College of Theology and Ministry presented Global Ministry and the Marketplace
- 7) New programs needing Senate approval were discussed and will be voted upon within 30 days. The College of Education and the College of Arts and Cultural Studies presented English Language Teaching in the Global Classroom.
