1. TOPIC: Opening

Dr. Kathaleen Reid-Martinez, Chair of the Academic Council, opened with prayer.

3. **TOPIC**: Report and possible discussion on the list of current members of the Student Learning Committee (SLC) and the Institutional Improvement University Committee (IIUC)

4. **TOPIC:** Discussion and vote on five proposed GO courses (three from Theology, one from Nursing, one from Sociology) from the Office of Global Service

DISCUSSION: Dr. Kevin Schneider presented the five proposed GO Courses (already approved by the GO Course subcommittee) to the Academic Council for a vote. It was discussed, recommended, and voted on (**Vote: Y: 17, N: 0, Abstain: 0**) that the procedure for approving new GO courses first go through: (1) Program Chair as a Curriculum Proposal, (2) Deans, (3) Academic Council GO Course Subcommittee, (4) Academic Council, (5) Provost, and (6) Registrar. This procedure will be followed for all new GO Courses with the exception of the following five GO Courses that were voted on and approved today and serve as part of a beta process to help determine the best way to process the GO courses:

6. **TOPIC**: Higher Education – University Planning Committee (UPC)

DISCUSSION: Dr. Reid-Martinez reported that the University Planning Committee's agenda included discussion of the future of education. One of the questions the UPC asked was, "where will we need to be in the future." Out of the assignments, two were related to academics. The questions that must be answered are (1) the future of faculty and what that looks like (Dr. Huntley was assigned this question) and (2) the future of curriculum, pedagogy, and the educational enterprise (Dr. Reid-Martinez and Dr. Weed were co-assigned this question). A list of faculty recommendations for this assignment were gathered for consideration so that the research can be completed by September 2018.

ACTION: Faculty recommendations will be given to Dr. Reid-Martinez for consideration to assist with this research.
