1. TOPIC: Opening

Dr. Kathaleen Reid-Martinez, Chair of the Academic Council, opened with prayer.

2. **TOPIC:** Approval of Minutes of the meeting on February 18, 2019.

Dr. Lang shared the proposed biennial review timeline of the SIC Exemption Review. Academic Council suggested that the review process be moved up two months earlier to October and that the report will be due biennially on January 31 at 11:59 p.m. **OPEN** 

4. **TOPIC:** Pre-Medicine/Pre-Health Professions Certificate program – Dr. Kenneth Weed

**DISCUSSION:** Dr. Weed reported that the Colleges need more time to discuss the Certificate program as they did not meet since the last Academic Council meeting in February.

**ACTION:** Discussion will be deferred to next month's Academic Council meeting to allow Colleges/Departments to discuss this topic. Dr. Weed will provide a statement to Academic Council members to give them points to discuss in their respective College meetings. Additionally, Dr. Reid-Martinez requested Dr. Weed provide evidence from medical schools supporting a certificate program.
