1. TOPIC: Opening

Dr. Kenneth Weed opened with prayer.

DISCUSSION: Mr. Jonathan Weed showed the Academic Council the Digital Diploma via Blockchain. It was explained that graduating students would automatically receive a link to their Digital Diploma and that past graduates who have not received a Digital Diploma could request one from the Registrar's office. Any request from alumni for a Digital Diploma would have current signatures on it that may not match signatures from their original diploma. Graduates who receive the Digital Diploma link can send it to prospective or current employers who would then have immediate access to proof of their diploma.

4. **TOPIC:** Updates from the Registrar's Office – Dr. Connie Sjoberg

5. TOPIC: General Education Committee Proposal: GEN 402 - Crafting Solutions to Global Health Issues - Dr. Andrew Lang

DISCUSSION: Dr. Lang let the Academic Council know that GEN 402 would be team taught over the summer by a minimum of two faculty. There were no objections raised during the discussion.

6. TOPIC: Faculty Emeriti - Dr. Kenneth Weed

DISCUSSION: An anonymous paper vote (or anonymous electronic for voting members attending via Zoom) for Faculty Emeriti was taken.

ACTION: The votes were given to Dr. Kenneth Weed to present to the Provost, Dr. Reid-Martinez. The Provost will forward the results to the President who will make recommendations to the Board of Trustees for their consideration during the April 2022 meeting.

7. TOPIC: Process for the consideration of the 2023-2024 Academic Calendar - Dr. Kenneth Weed

DISCUSSION: The Academic Council members discussed possible schedule changes and impacts on diversifying the types of experiences students have and how faculty shape those experiences. One member stated that fewer weeks in a semester (regardless of hours in class) result in less time outside of class for students to complete academic requirements while balancing work and other extracurricular activities. Another asked what the economic return would be of any impact on enrollment versus the academic costs to the learners. A suggestion was made for returning to a 50-minute classes on MWF by adopting the alternative schedule and starting the semester two days earlier. However, the Registrar's office said that a Monday or Tuesday start to the semester is difficult due to the extra staff required to cover move-in activities over the weekend. Lastly, a suggestion was made to poll student opinion concerning the academic calendar. The Registrar's office reported that students have an ORU chat app that would make such a survey possible.

ACTION: Academic Council members will discuss the academic calendar in their departments/colleges and revisit the topic during the March 2022 Academic Council meeting. **OPEN**
