Additionally, there was a request by Dr. Wheat for IT to add a new feature to DegreeWorks to automatically clear the advisor attribute from a student record upon graduation. The Registrar's Office will work with IT to determine if this process can be automated. **ACTION**: The Provost requested the Registrar work with IT to find a solution and report

back to the Academic Council.
