Start of Meeting	11A.M.
Devotional	The meeting began with a devotional led by Dr. Larry Hart. He anchored the devotion in Mark 11:24 and encouraged the faculty to make Worship the goal of what we do and of our lives. Dr. Hart elaborated on Faith making specific reference to <i>Persistent Faith, Pilgrimage Faith, Seed Faith, Saving Faith, and the Gift of Faith.</i> He challenged the ORU community to live by Mark 11:24 this year.
Door Prizes	Mrs. Lisa Wilson and Lisa Bowman distributed door prizes to selected faculty. The theme for the door prizes was Globalization.
President's report	Dr. Wilson reported on the Parent Weekend which had over 300 parents in attendance. He also mentioned the Grand Opening of the GLC on January 11, 2017 adding that one of the rooms was named after one of the founding faculty members Dr. George Gillen.  Dr. Wilson also mentioned that at the Board of Trustees (BOT) Retreat contemplation was given to the review of the Five-Year Adaptive Plan. He stated that the University Planning Council (UPC) reviews of the plan to include suggestions from the BOT. He also noted that the BOT will review and approve changes to the plan in the April 2017 meeting. The final plan will then be implemented after the BOT's approval. Dr. Wilson also informed the faculty that in continuation of his listening tour and visit with the constituents of the university he was conducting a Listening Forum with the students in the GLC on January 30, 2017. He also plans to visit some classes from each of the colleges as a student.

Highlights of the report included the following: <ul> <li>An update from the Institute for General Education and Assessment (IGEA) General Education Review Team presented by Dr. Curtis Ellis and Professor Denise Miller.</li> <li>The IGEA team's availability as consultants to departments and colleges.</li> <li>The appointment of an Ad Hoc Committee to (Dr. Andrew Lang, Mr. David Fulmer- University Registrar, and college dean appointed faculty members) address the consideration of credit hours required for graduation. The committee will provide monthly updates of findings to the Academic Council.</li> <li>Recommendation of a new one-hour course, GEN 150, Introduction to the Whole Person Education to be taken by all incoming students.</li> </ul> </li> <li>A copy of the Provost's Summary Report was distributed to all faculty members in attendance.</li> <li>Motions to accept the report were made by Drs. Agena Farmer and Sonny Branham and unanimously accepted by the faculty.</li> </ul>
GEN 150- Introduction to Whole Person Education	After a short period of questions and answer and discussion the majority of the faculty voted to accept the proposed GEN 150 course (there were 7 abstentions) with corrections to the section Purpose <i>Of The Course</i> Sentence #1 part (1) which now

	reads "The Purpose of this course is three-fold: introduce students to the key elements of Whole Person Education;"	
General Education Review Update General Education Review Team	Copies of the report were distributed to those in attendance at the meeting. Then Dr. Curtis Ellis presented a preliminary Report for the University Faculty Review and Comment on behalf of the General Education Review Team. The report addressed three main areas:  Proposed revision of ORU Proficiencies A Preliminary Proposed General Education Model, and A Proposed New Graduation Requirement  Members of faculty were given the opportunity to field some questions to the team (Drs. Curtis Ellis, Cal Easterling and Andy Lang and Denise Miller).	
President Wilson	Dr. Wilson encouraged faculty members to engage in further discussions at the college level and to submit their revisions and drafts to General Education Review Team. He assured faculty that the intention is not to make rushed decisions but to have full faculty buy-in so that we can have a quality product that we can be proud of. He expressed his understanding that more time might be needed and if so that would be the case.  President Wilson indicated that faculty will have a chance to vote whether or not they wanted to have future luncheon meetings at the GC (Trustee Dining Room) or the GLC.
