Dr. Wilson spent much of fall break in Turkey, recording segments for World Impact. As happens all over the world, he encountered parents and grandparents of ORU alumni.

Dr. Reid-Martinez recently returned from China, where two MOUs were signed. Mike Matthews was a keynote speaker at an international conference on Virtual Reality held in Nanchang, China.

ORU IT partnered with Social Work to create realistic training videos to prepare social work students for difficult situations they will encounter in professional practice.

The Sports Park was dedicated October 23rd. This provides space for several types of field sports—including the rugby team, which is having an excellent season.

The Music Task force, an advisory group of accomplished musicians, has been meeting with the Music department.
