Facts about the incoming freshman class: -largest single high school group was homeschooled, followed by Tulsa area schools -highschool GPA was an overall 3.56 -SAT 1100, ACT 22 (relatively few took these tests) -241 entered with some college credit, 103 with Advantage Program credits -The number of Advantage partner schools and states indicate strong growth. Covid Update-Lori Cook, Dean of Students The Health & Safety Taskforce continues to monitor CDC guidelines and conditions on campus. See the ORU website for an up-to-date guide. Free testing is provided for staff and students and reporting protocols are in place. Athletics-Tim Johnson, Athletic Director Men's and women's soccer are already having successful seasons. Student and staff enthusiasm and attendance is rising. The student-athletes appreciate the support.
