- 6. **TOPIC:** Academic Council Report—Provost
  - Academic Council subcommittee to develop procedures formed
  - Revised Curriculum Change Form submitted for review
  - List of committee assignments submitted to University Faculty. Committees will begin meeting in September.
  - Academic Council recommends to University Faculty beginning a comprehensive review of general education in August 2015.
  - Objective 3.4: College of Science and Engineering initiating an intentional program of student-engaged research. New Experimental Psychology lab completed.
  - Proposal to Academic Council concerning BA vs. BS conversion policy returned for further review.

**ACTION:** Academic Council report received as read. Motion: Marcia Livingston; Second: David Dyson; Vote to approve was unanimous with no one opposed or abstaining.

- 7. **TOPIC**: Comprehensive General Education Review proposal
  - Representing the General Education Curriculum Committee, Dr. Lori Kanitz detailed the recommendation from Academic Council to initiate a comprehensive review of general education.
  - Current ORU General Education program is currently two-tiered with no connection to professional learning with courses limited to 100 level courses with one exception.
  - Propose a three-year process with Year 1 for open comment, Year 2 for committee recommendations, and Year 3 for implementation strategies

<u>ACTION</u>: In addition to the motion from the Academic Council, a motion and second was accepted from the floor to initiate a comprehensive review of General Education. Vote to approve was unanimous with no one opposed or abstaining.
