TUITION BENEFITS:

The Qualified Tuition Reduction Program ("Program") provides tuition reduction to an Eligible Employee, Eligible Dependent(s), and Eligible Married Child(ren) who enroll in courses provided by the University. To the extent the Program meets the requirements of Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") §117(d), the benefits provided to an Eligible Employee and/or Eligible Dependent(s)/Eligible Married Child(ren) under the Program are excludable from gross income.

The Educational Assistance Plan ("Plan") provides tuition waiver or reimbursement to Eligible Employees for a portion of the cost of approved educational courses. To the extent, the Plan meets the requirements of Internal Revenue Code ("IRC") §127, the benefits provided to Eligible Employees under the Plan are excludable from gross income.

Professional Development: Through the Professional Development Plan ("PDP"), ORU recognizes the importance of our employees enhancing their knowledge, expertise, experience, and capabilities through educational programs and/or activities, which exceed or are in addition to the bachelor's degree. For approved requests, ORU will pay up to (subject to budgetary constraints and funding) 100% of the tuition, including approved textbooks, materials, laboratory fees, registration fees, examination fees, or travel and lodging
