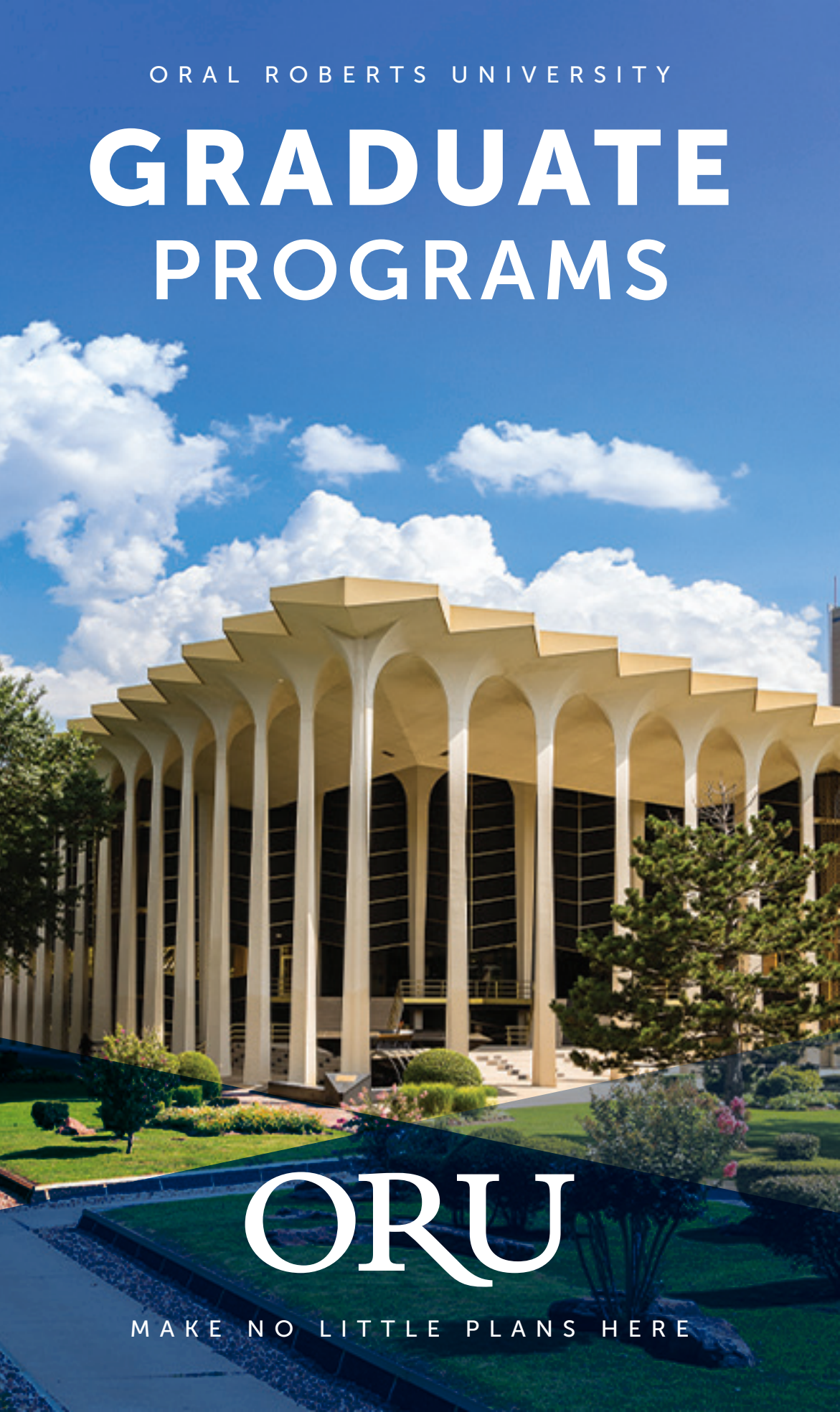

FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

GRADUATE QUEST WHOLE PERSON FELLOW AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For consideration of the Graduate Quest Whole Person Fellow and Scholarship Program, students must first be admitted to ORU for eligibility. This unique program awards one President's Fellow, three Dean's Fellows and additional scholarships to qualified students. A Fellow is a one-year, renewable award that includes full-tuition and a \$15,000 assistantship stipend. Also, the President's Fellow receives on-campus room and board. Opportunities for Fellow awards are offered as vacancies occur. Those not selected for a Fellow award are eligible to receive scholarships that range from \$500–\$5,000. Scholarships are subject to available funds for that year and may be used in combination with Academic and Alumni Scholarships. To learn more about this opportunity, visit: quest.oru.edu/grad.*

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Awards range from \$1,000 to \$2,200 and may be prorated for part-time enrollment. Students not awarded an academic scholarship upon admission to the graduate program will be eligible for a \$1,000 annual scholarship awarded after the successful completion of 12 graduate (master's not leveling) hours with a 3.2 GPA (Business, and Theology and Ministry) or 3.0 GPA (Education).

PH.D. PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP

Theology Ph.D. Fellow offers 100% tuition coverage and additional benefits year round as determined by Ph.D program.*

U.S. MILITARY DISCOUNT

\$500 per full-time semester for active and retired U.S. military members.

ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

\$500 per full-time semester for ORU graduates.

MINISTRY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be vocationally serving in full-time ministry. This scholarship is available only for students enrolled in a Graduate School of Theology & Ministry program and cannot be combined with other Graduate Theology & Ministry scholarships.

CHRISTIAN SCHOOL SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must be serving full-time at a Christian school. This scholarship is available only for students enrolled in a Graduate School of Education program and cannot be combined with other Graduate Education Scholarships.
