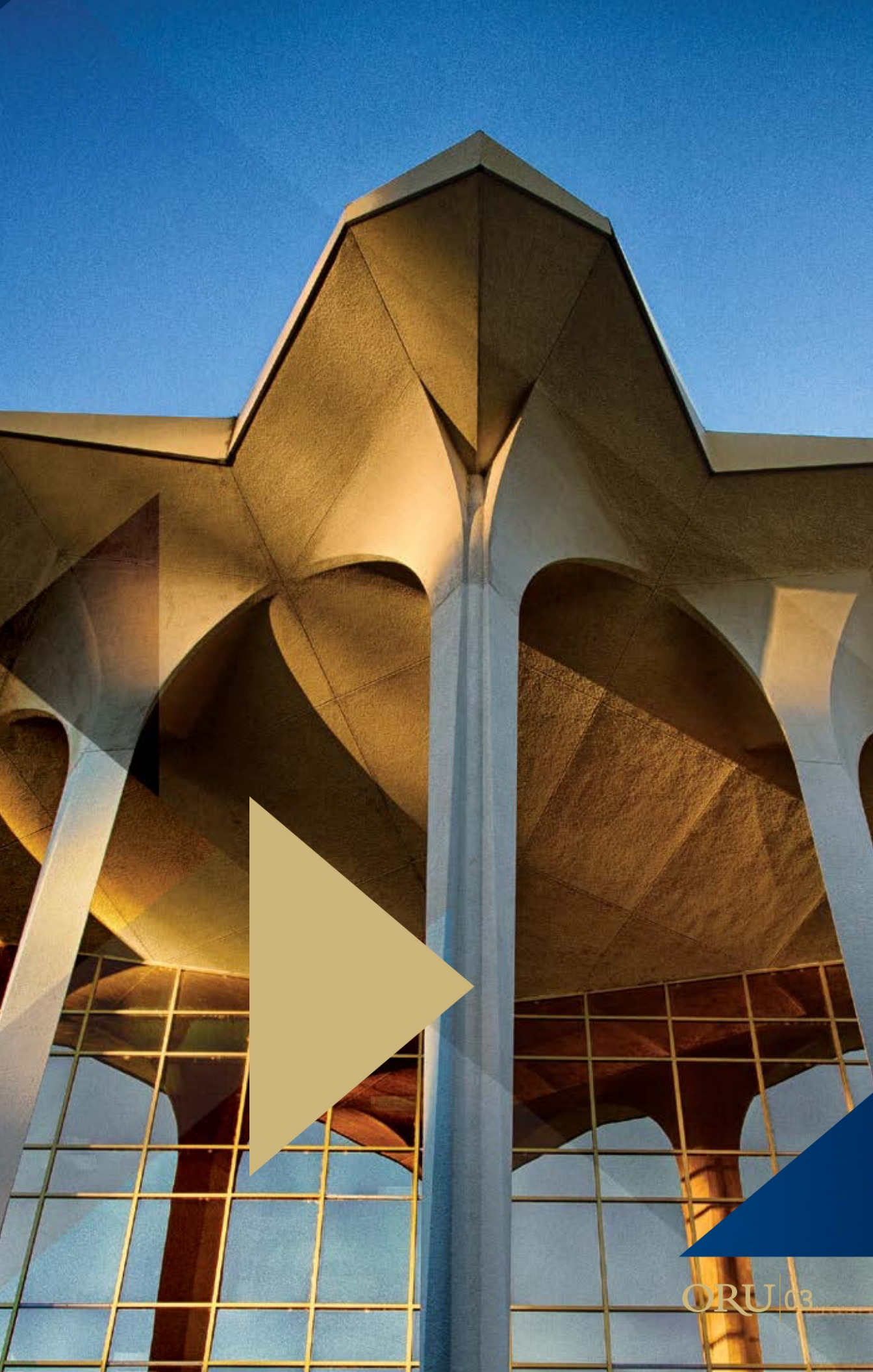

## ANNA VAUGHN COLLEGE OF NURSING

The strength of the Anna Vaughn College of Nursing (AVCON) nursing program lies in our equal emphasis on academic rigor and clinical experience.

The curriculum is structured to assure that graduates are competent to begin practice within a complex and ever-changing healthcare environment. Comprehensive coursework – including liberal arts, physical and social sciences, as well as professional nursing courses – gives students a working foundation for success, with a **93%** passing rate on the National Council Licensure Examination for registered nurses last year. Each of ORU's seasoned faculty members from the College of Nursing maintain a part-time professional nursing practice and are continually evaluating our curriculum against the changes and demands of modern health care.

- ▶ During the summer, ORU Nursing students are able to participate in a medical mission trip to places like the Dominican Republic. In 2013, students worked closely with doctors to gain valuable practical experience and saw more than **1,000** patients on the trip.

## COLLEGE OF SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING

The College of Science and Engineering encompasses four departments including Behavioral Science; Biology and Chemistry; Computing and Mathematics; Engineering; and Health, Leisure and Sports Sciences. The college creates an extraordinary academic context fully informed by a Christian worldview, while simultaneously offering a broad spectrum of integrated degree programs, both within the college and beyond.

Students are given opportunities to participate with field-experienced professors who have ongoing research in numerous areas, further enriching the classroom. Our faculty has an open door policy, and our small student to faculty ratio allows for both the pursuit of knowledge and thorough mentoring.

- ▶ We have a post-graduate medical school acceptance rate of **86%** for students with a GPA of **3.6** or greater, which is higher than the national average

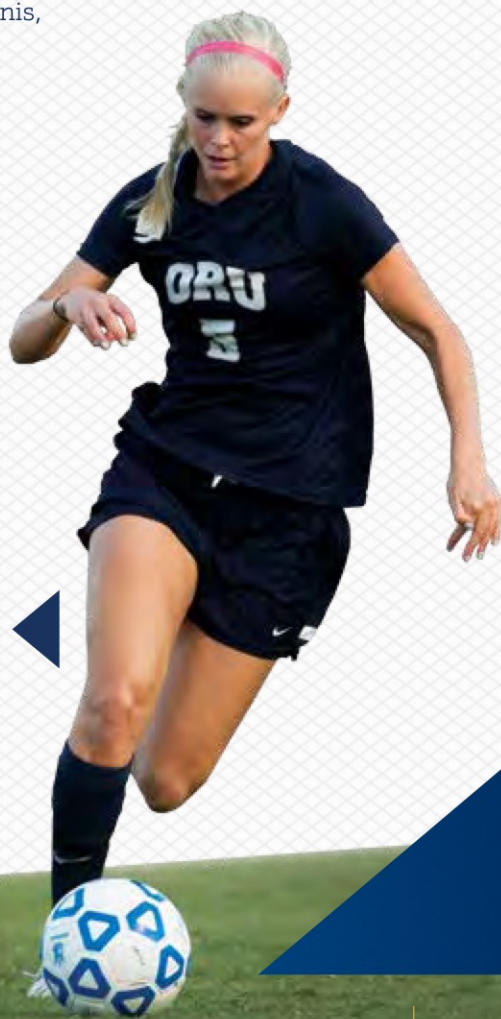
